### Oregon Public Universities and IB

- For all Oregon public colleges and universities
- Credit for both SL and HL exams with a score of 5 or better
- Credit for IB Diploma with score of 30 points or more (up to 45 credit hours)
- Many perks for DP graduates

## IB Diploma Requirements

- 24 points minimum on 6 subjects
- 12 pts minimum total on 3 HL subjects
- Bonus points available for ToK and EE
- Successful completion of CAS
- Must pass ToK, EE, and CAS

#### How are IB scores calculated?

- Internal assessment done by teacher
- External assessment done by IB
- Each subject has a its own % total
- Teacher is both coach and examiner
- Students MUST complete IA on time
- IA scores are moderated by IB
- EA scores are moderated by IB
- Scores are on a 1 7 scale
- Examiners are world-wide

## Registration update for 2018

- Students approved for Free or Reduced lunch do not pay. Their exam costs are covered by the State of Oregon but they MUST test.

- Complete form with signatures
- Bring check to Ms. Fideler or pay online
- Free or Reduced Lunch approval letter and permission to share
- Nonrefundable after Nov 15.
- Must test or pay drop fee
- Bring form and receipt to C210
