Please take these guidelines to your photographer to ensure that student photos complement one another and represent each student well for a lifetime!

Your picture should: <ul style="list-style-type: none">● be cropped to the head & shoulders/mid-torso● be in color● have a neutral/simple background● show you looking at the camera.	File Size Recommendations: <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 2 in. x 3 in.● Files smaller than ~300k will not print well.● Jpeg files preferred.● Use full-resolution files, no screenshots or previews.

Reasons pictures are rejected:

- File size
- Cropping too tight to place in yearbook. (Not enough headroom)
- Submitted after deadline/publication date
- Inappropriate background/hand-gestures/clothing/props.

How to Submit Your Photo

You may need to ask/remind your photographer to do this! You will receive an e-mail confirmation once we have the photo and it meets our requirements.

Efforts will be made to include photos submitted after Nov. 15, but inclusion is not guaranteed. We will automatically include your school picture if you don't turn in a photo.
