

Southridge High School Hall of Fame Nomination Criteria

The Southridge High School Hall of Fame is the highest honor bestowed by Southridge High School. The Southridge High School Hall of Fame recognizes alumni for their athletic, academic, artistic, service to community, contributions to the character of Southridge High School and their prominence after graduation. All nominees to the Hall of Fame will serve as ambassadors of Southridge High School and provide inspiration to future Skyhawks. These individuals must be of good moral character, with outstanding leadership qualities and must be held in high esteem by their colleagues, coaches and alumni.

All nominations must fit the criteria of one of the six categories below. All nominations must include detailed supporting information, which could include media articles, proof of awards, letters of support from others, etc. If assistance is needed in compiling information about a nominee, they should contact the Southridge High School before the nomination is submitted.

Nominations for the Southridge High School Hall of Fame must be received by **December 1st** of each year. The Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony will be held in conjunction with a home football game the following fall.

CRITERIA REQUIREMENT FOR NOMINATION

CRITERIA FOR ALL CATEGORY

- Individuals must be either be a Southridge graduate and have left school in good standing and remain in good standing or an individual who gave service to Southridge High School in form of a coach, director, volunteer, staff member or community partner.
- Former students must have attended Southridge for a minimum of two years.
- Individuals are not eligible for nomination until five years after graduation or service to the school.
- A team may be nominated as an entity, but is not eligible for nomination until five years after graduation.

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION FOR EACH CATEGORY

ATHLETE:

- Must have received recognition for exceptional athletic performance such as all-league, all-state, All-American honors, league or state championships, or collegiate or professional athletic participation.
 - **Nominating information for athletes should include:** high school playing record, league/state championship participation and place finishes, league honors, state honors, achievements and athletic participation since graduation and a biographical sketch.

PERFORMING ART/ACTIVITIES:

 Must have received recognition for exceptional performance such as all-league, all-state, or league and state championships. Individuals may also have contributed to the advancement of the performing arts community by participating in ensembles beyond the high school stage, at the collegiate level, or beyond.

Nominating information for should include: high school record, league/state championship participation and place finishes, league honors, state honors, achievements and participation since graduation and a biographical sketch.

COACH:

- Must uphold the ideals and philosophies of Southridge High School athletics while striving to serve
 the best interests of high school athletics. While winning championships might be a factor, the primary
 concern is a person's effect upon the student-athletes and fellow coaches he/she has influenced.
- Must have served as a coach at Southridge High School for five years or more.
- Must have compiled a significant number of wins or produced a high winning percentage relative to the sports history.

Nomination information for coaches should include: sports coached (with win/loss records), state championships competed in by that coach's teams (with years and place finishes), league, district and state championships won by nominee's teams (with years), league/state honors received, committees or associations served and a biographical sketch

TEAM:

- Must be a team that accomplished high ranking or high placing in league and state competition (i.e. state tournament appearances, state placing).
- Should have won one or multiple league or state championships.
- Teams should have brought prestige to Southridge High School in their actions in and out of the athletic arena.

Nomination information for teams should include: sport, year and head coach's name; names of all athletes on team, names of all assistant coaches, league championship, state championship participation and place finishes, and a season summary.

MERITORIOUS SERVICE:

- Must exhibit dedication and loyalty to Southridge High School.
- Their work must have made a concrete and lasting contribution to the welfare of the Southridge High School

Nomination information for meritorious service should include: relationship to the SRHS programs, contributions to program, years or service to Southridge High School (if an employee), contributions to state or national organizations, league or OSAA, honors received and specific reasons for nomination.

Significant Individuals: May include one of the following administrators, parents, staff, BSD employees, booster club members, business people who have made outstanding contributions to Southridge High School.

HONORARY:

This category is reserved for persons who do not meet the complete criteria in any of the above nomination categories but who, in the determination of the committee, are of high enough merit and quality to warrant induction into the Hall of Fame. Induction as an honorary member must be approved unanimously by the committee.
